Students were asked to maintain a department log-book which were checked regularly by the department faculty. ACADEMIC PROGRAMME FOR UNDER GRADUATES

- Regular theory classes are being conducted for 2nd year (20 hours), 3rd year (30 hours), 4th year (80 hours) including integrated classes(interdepartmental).At the end 3-4 regular theory classes, formative assessment is conducted by the staff. At the end of each term, theory internal assessment is conducted.
- UG's during the clinical postings (3rd, 4th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th term), for 3-4 weeks on average are divided unit wise. They attend the bedside clinics, OPD and ward rounds on allotted days according to the units. The students are also allotted cases for learner doctor method, which is included in the curriculum. At the end of each clinical postings, clinical assessment is conducted including log book correction.
- Skill lab is held regularly during each term. UG's are demonstrated the procedure/skill initially by the staff, later the students are made to perform the same.
- Self-directed learning in 3rd year (10 hours), 4th year (40 hours) is held as per curriculum. UG's are encouraged to read an allotted topic using various resources in the allotted hour and tested at the end of the study period, responses are documented for the same.
- SGD (small group discussion) is also conducted for 3rd years (30 hours) and 4th years (80 hours). SGD is subdivided into smaller groups and a topic is allotted, which is to be discussed within the subgroups under the supervision of the staff. Important points are conveyed at the end of the discussion.
- AETCOM MODULES (attitude, ethics and communication) as per the curriculum is conducted for 4th year students for 14 hours, in which students are encouraged to do role play for the allotted topic, at the end important points are highlighted.
- Pandemic modules as per the Curriculum is conducted for fourth year students in which students are exposed to medical and psychological management of pandemics including emergency procedures as integrated sessions with department of Anesthesia and Pulmonology.
- They are encouraged to participate in various CME/conferences/Quiz programs. They have also won prizes

1. As per NMC rules and regulations, postgraduate academic activities are conducted on a regular basis including subject seminars, tutorials, journal clubs and clinical case presentations. Teaching program also includes clinic-pathological case presentations mortality meetings and various Continuing Medical Education programs.
2. Bedside rounds and case discussions are held on a daily basis to assess clinical skills of postgraduate students.
3. Internal assessment (both theory and practicals) are done regular in ordination with NMC norms.
4. Each postgraduate during their course are posted to ICU and superspeciality departments on rotation basis.

6. The postgraduates participate at national/state level conferences and CMEs are conducted regularly in the department.
7. Two Karnataka Medical Council accredited CME was conducted in the Department in 2024. Upskilling pulmonology skills for postgraduate students in May 2024 and Rheumatology & Immunology- Fundamentals for residents in August 2024.
